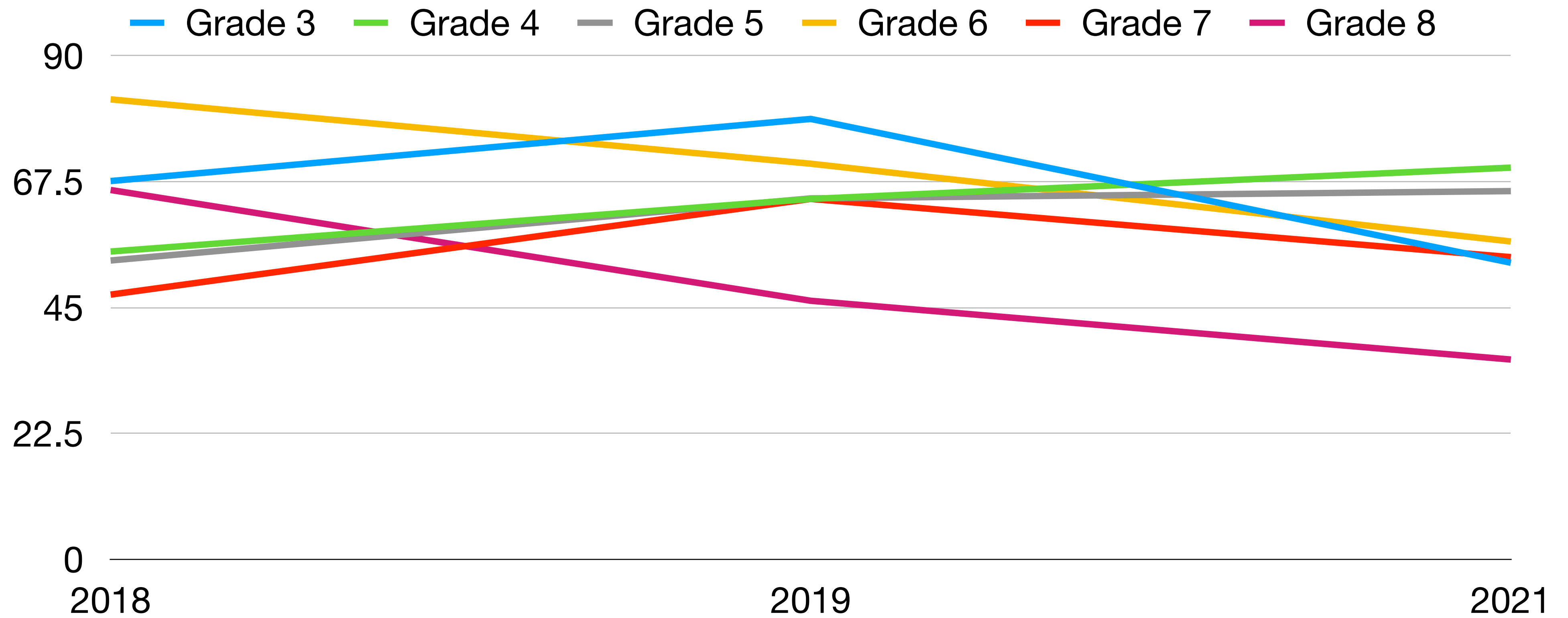
Percent of Riverview Students Met Or Exceeds Standards

Percent of Riverview Students Met Or Exceeds Standards

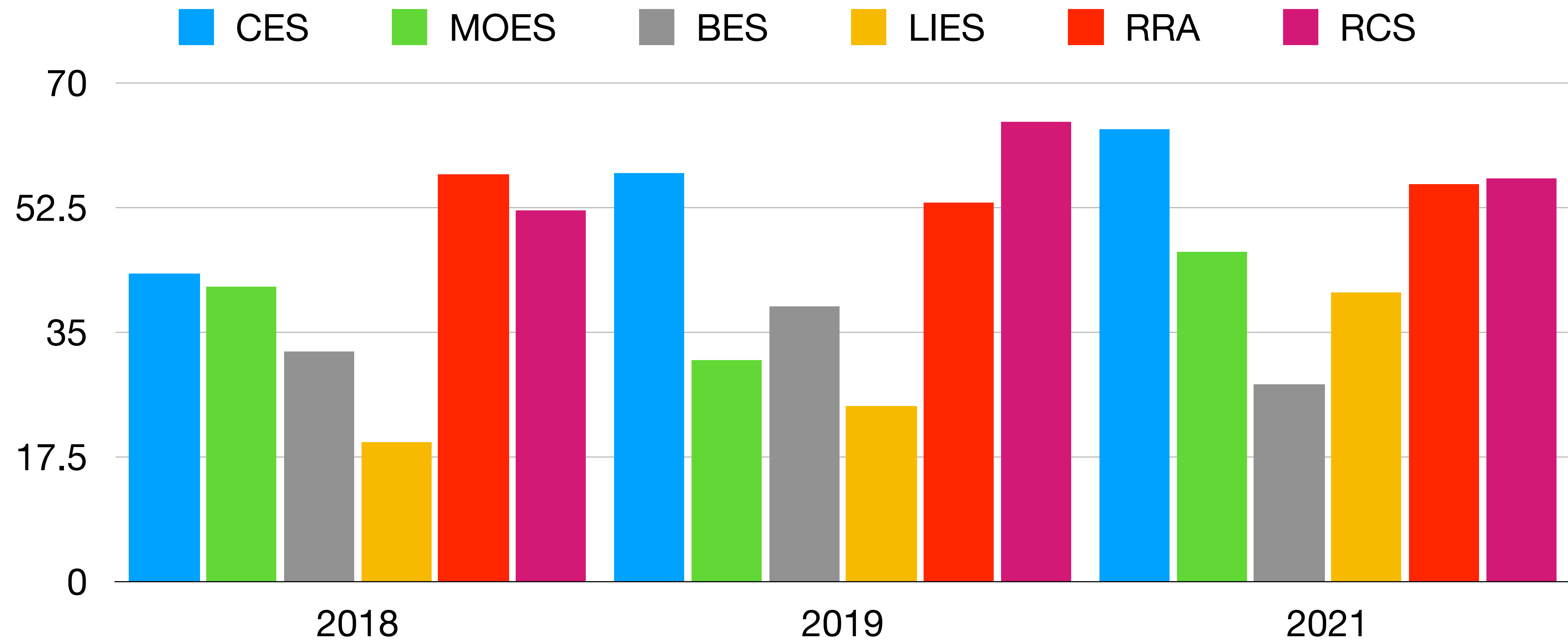

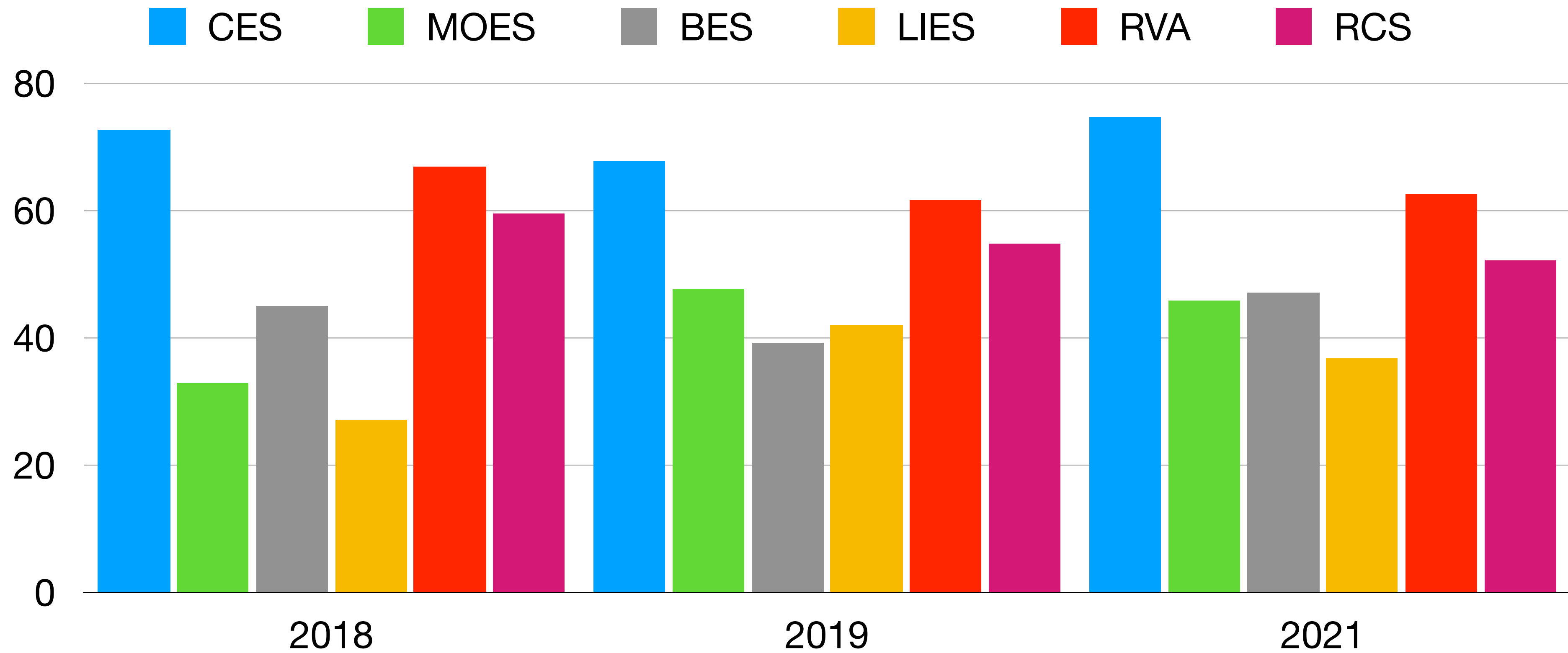

Grade 5 School Comparison



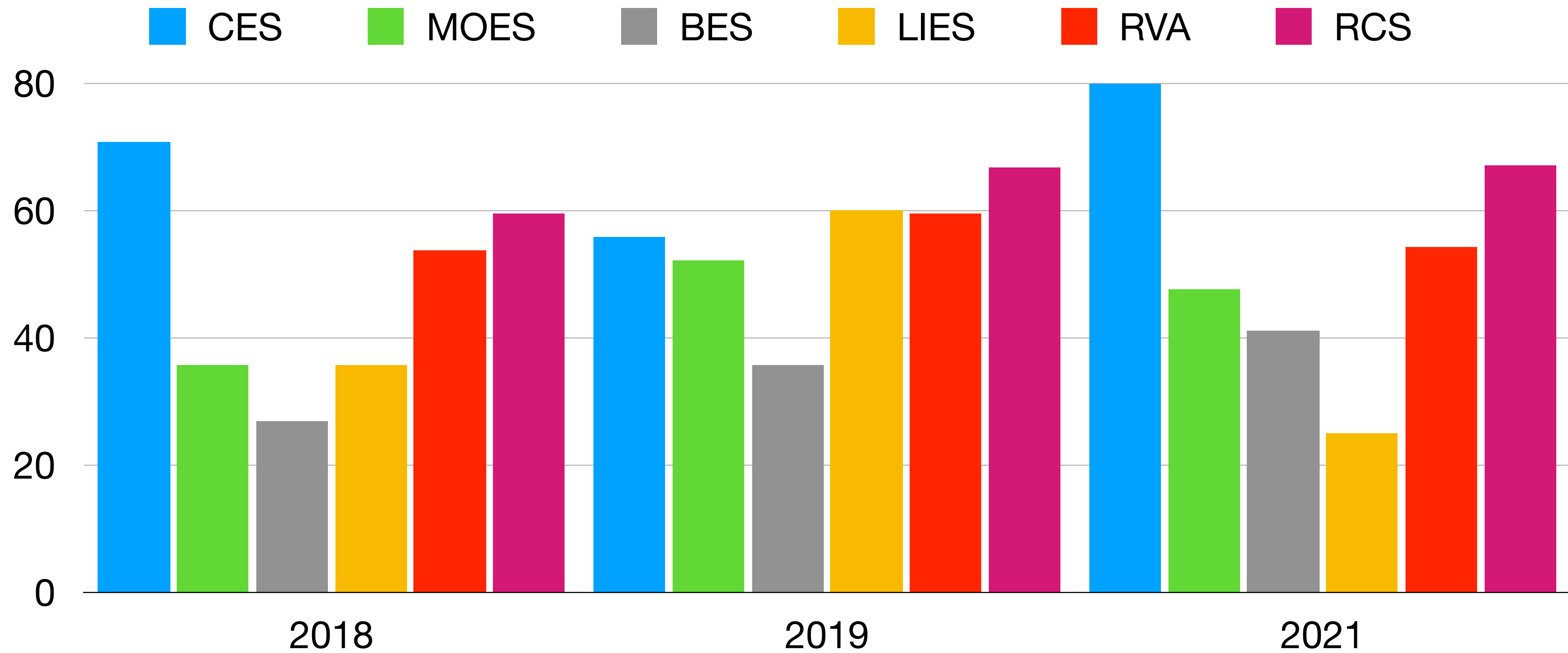
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds ELA

Grade 4 School Comparison



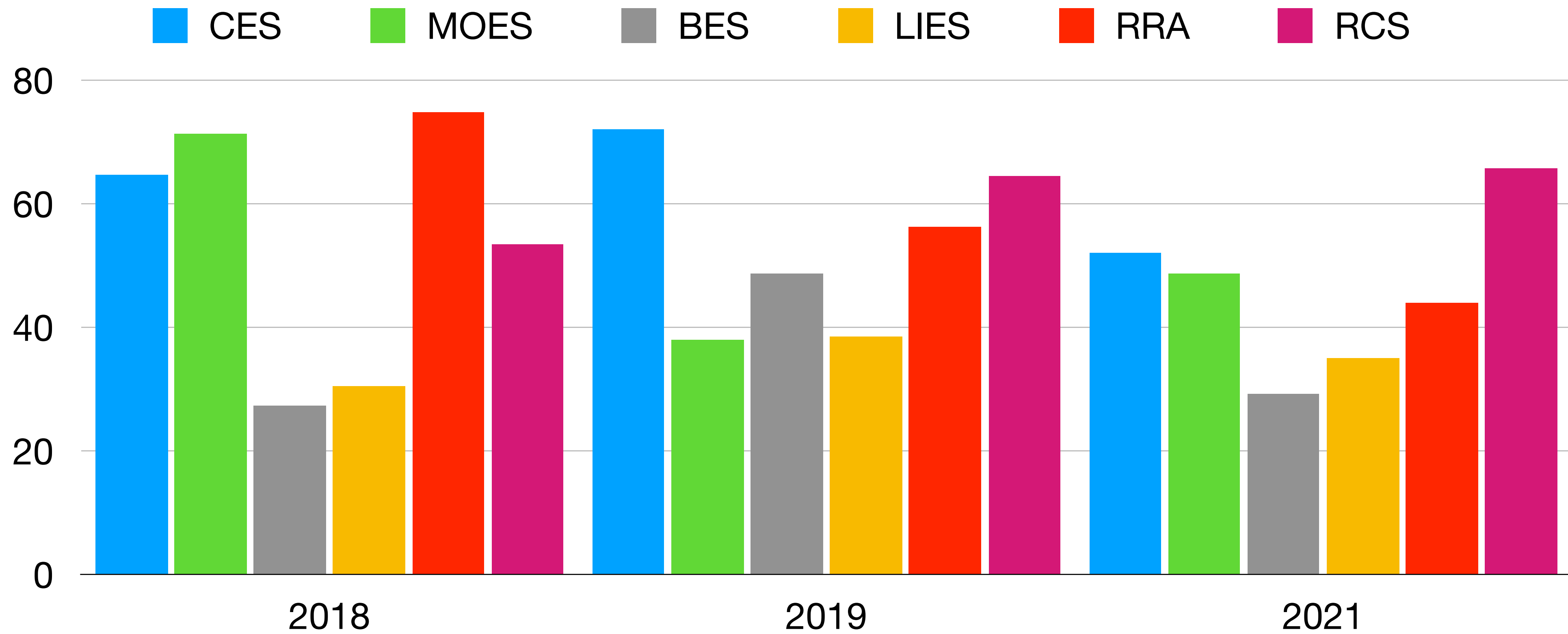
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds ELA

Grade 3 School Comparison



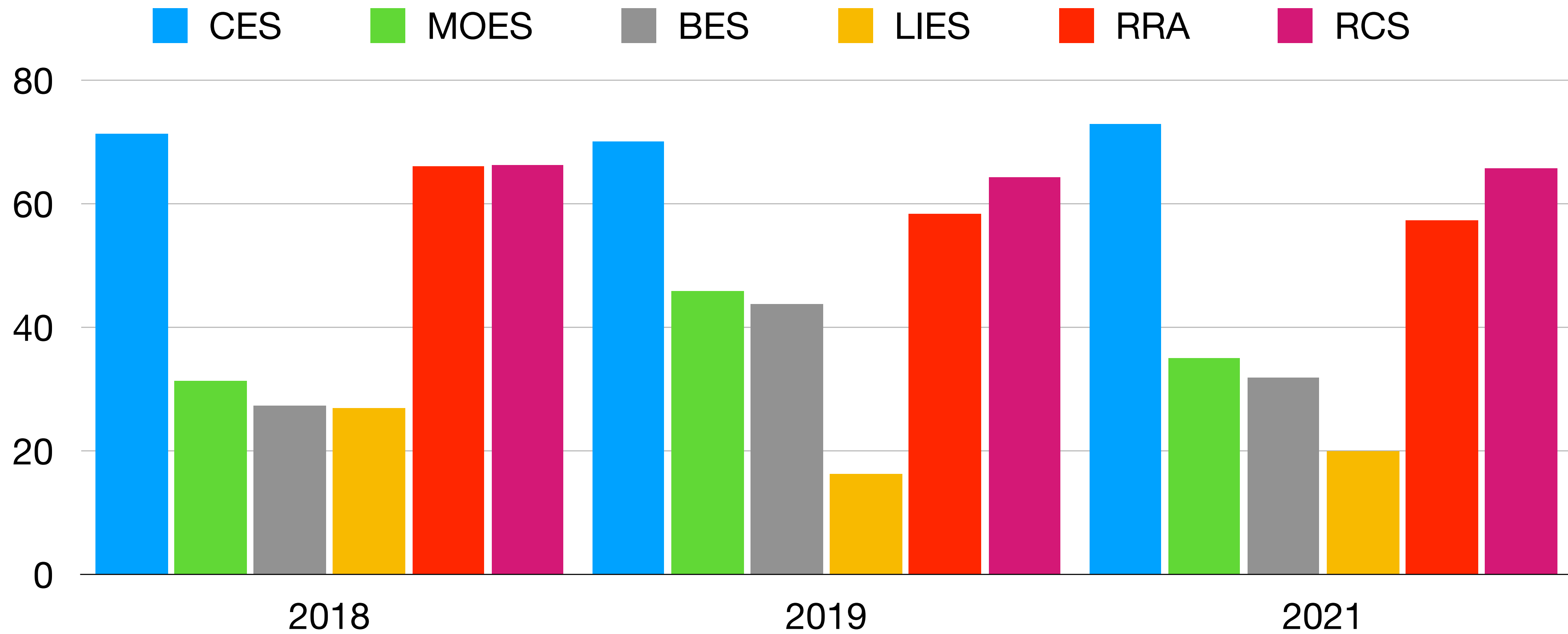
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds Math

Grade 5 School Comparison



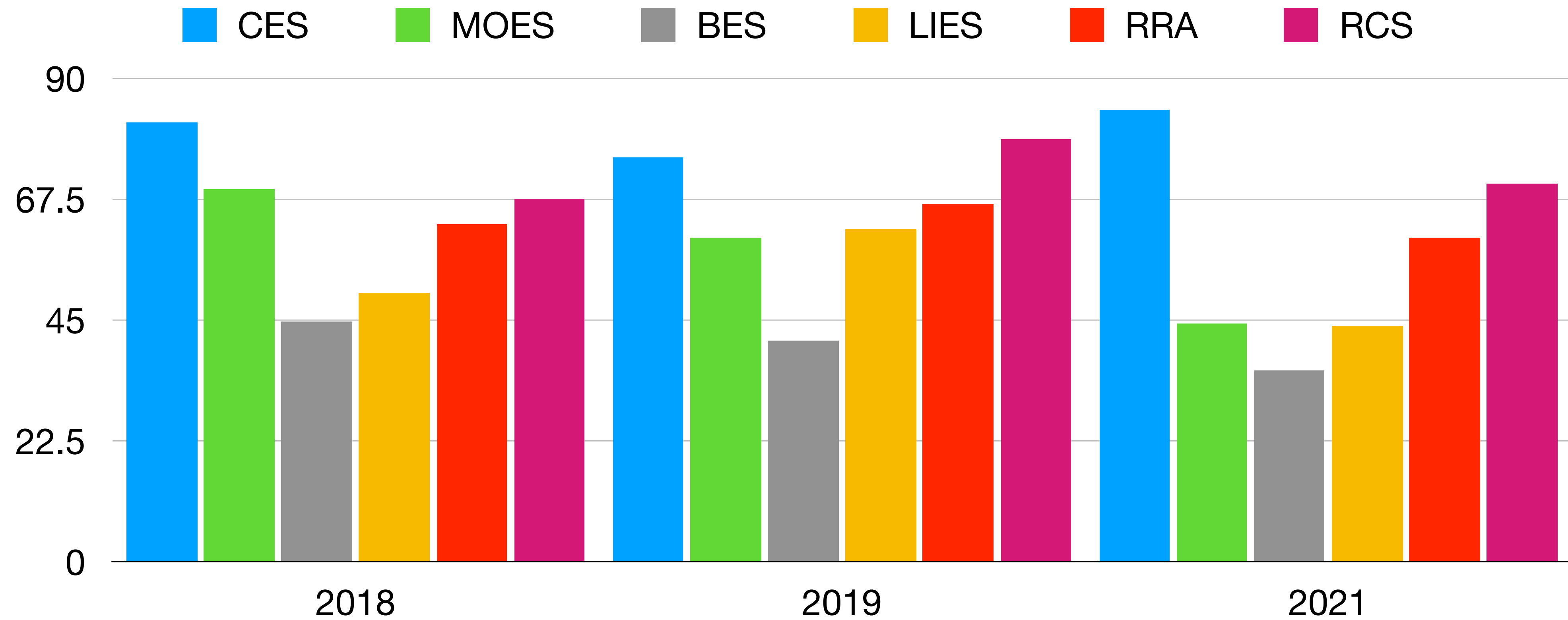
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds Math

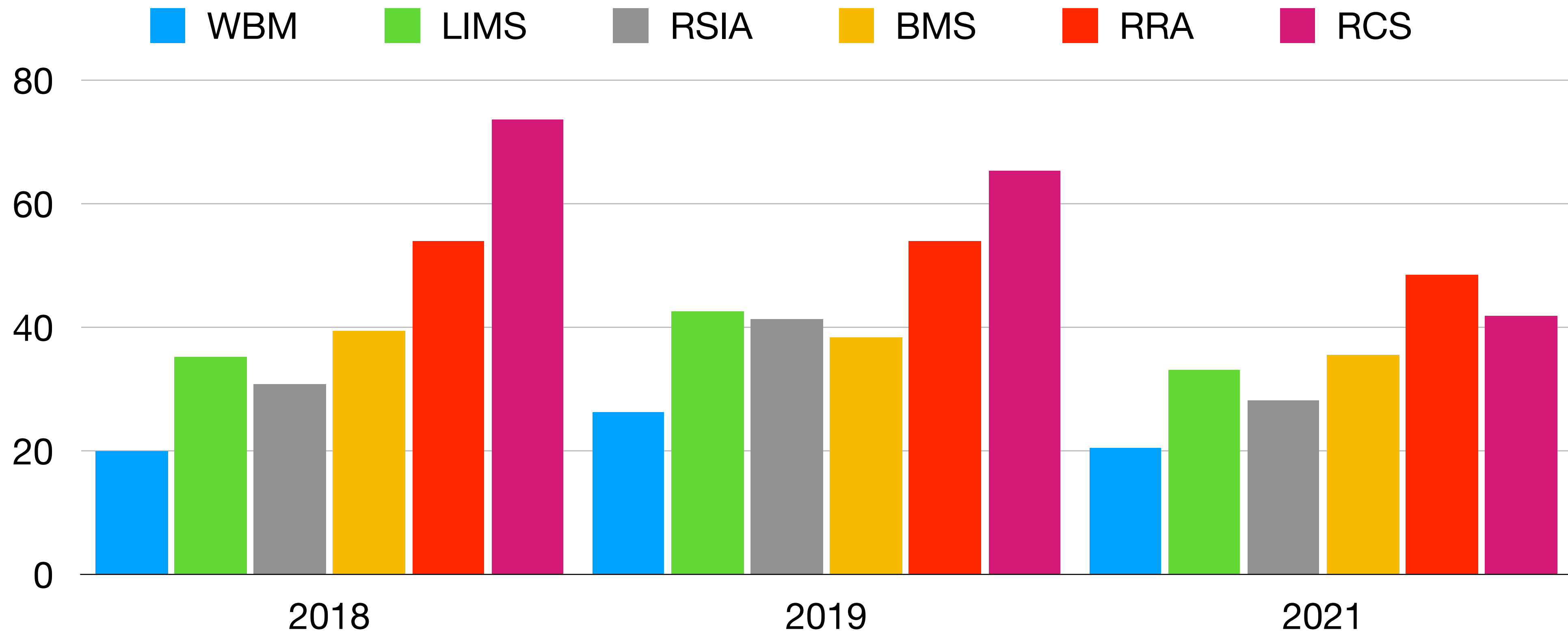

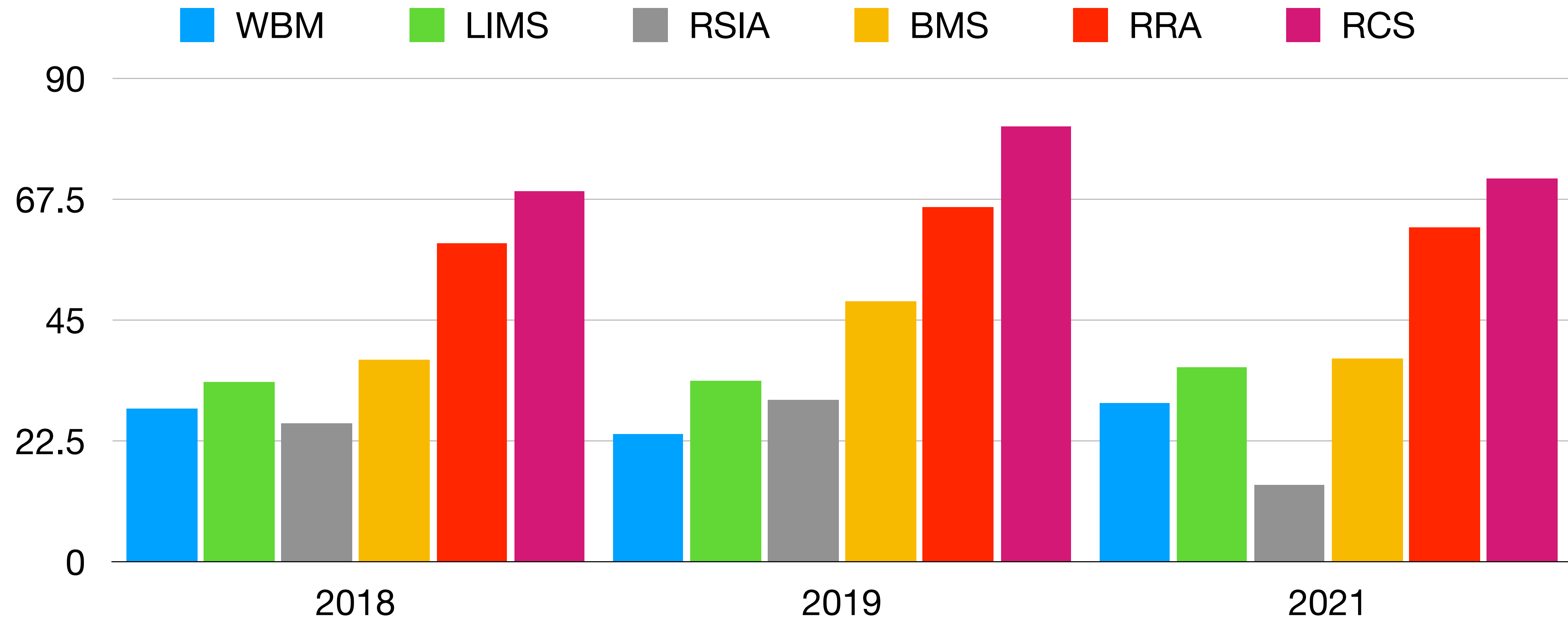

Grade 8 School Comparison



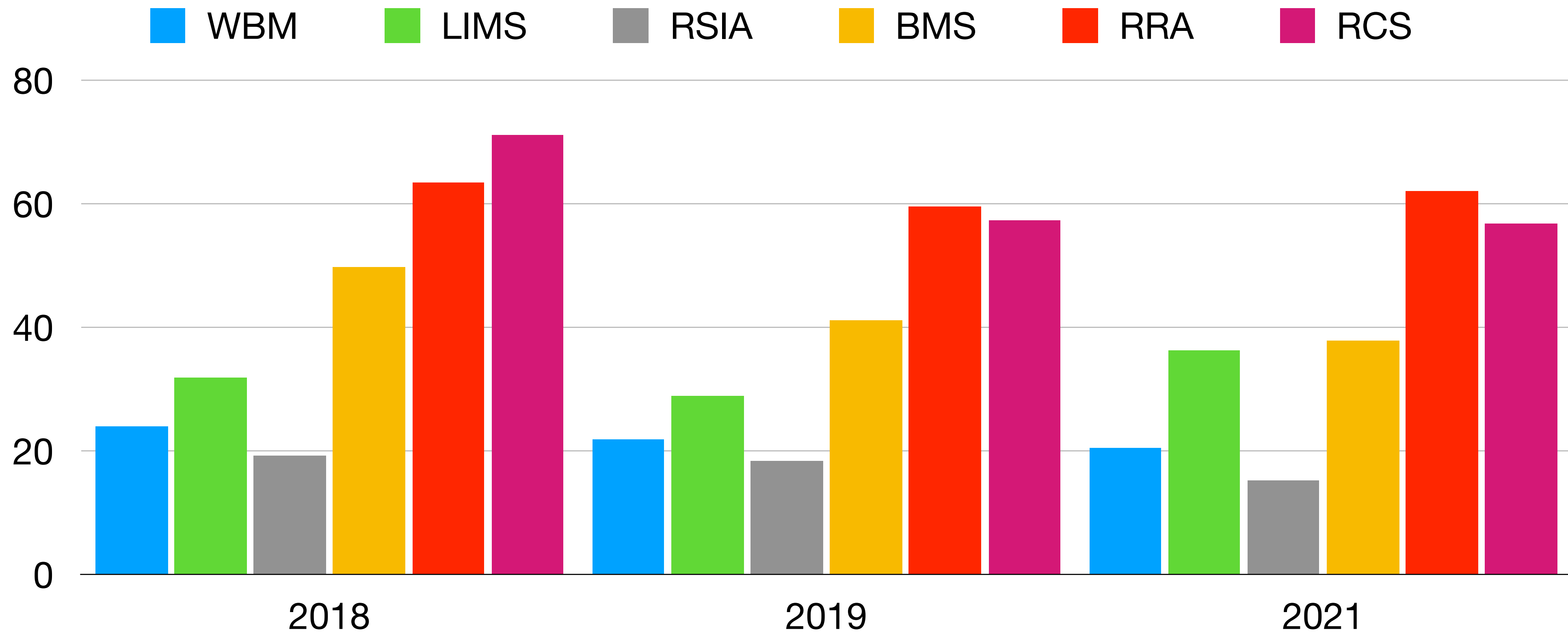
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds ELA

Grade 7 School Comparison



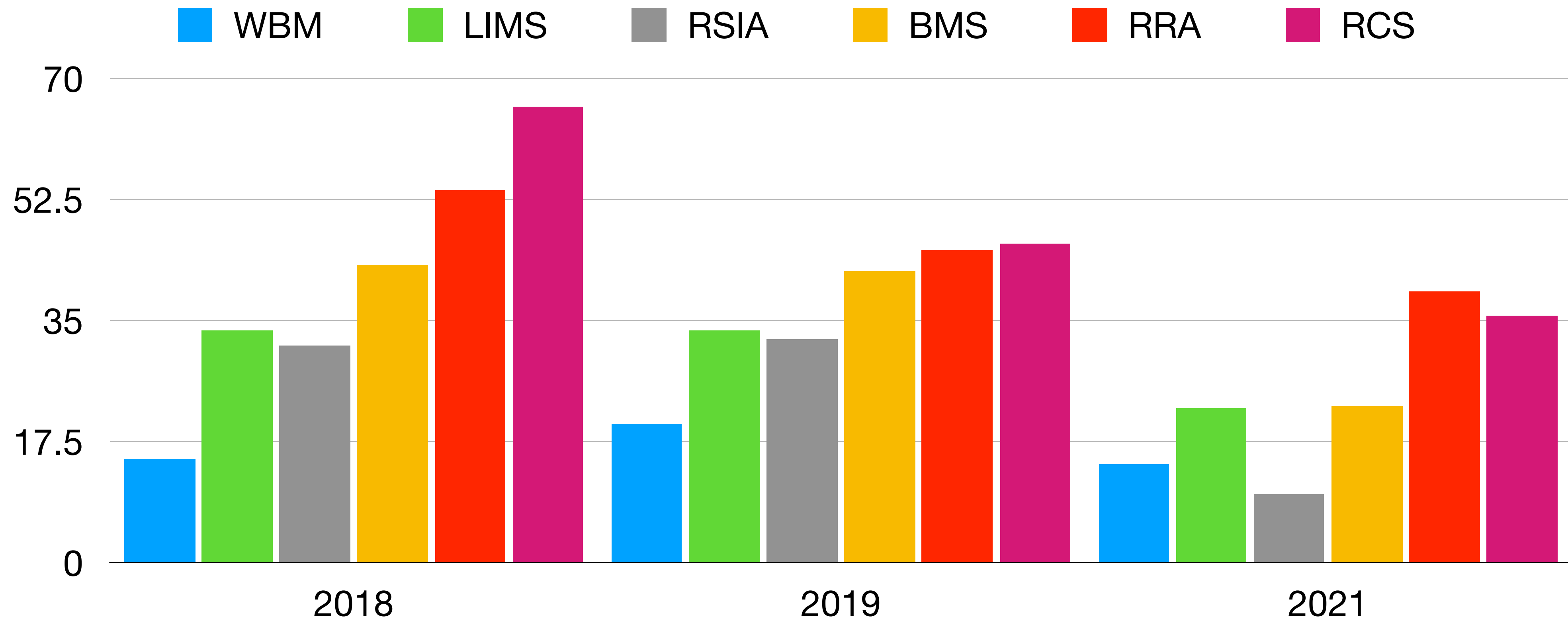

Grade 6 School Comparison



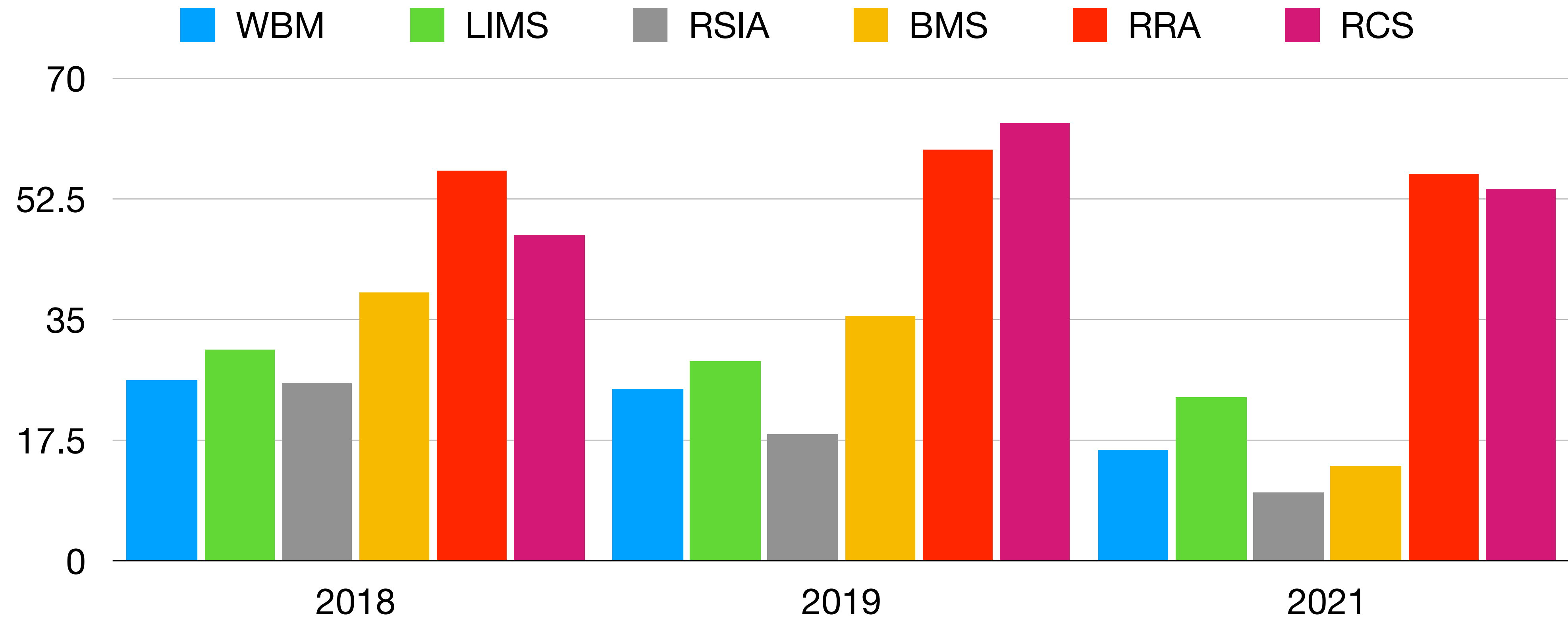
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds Math

Grade 8 School Comparison



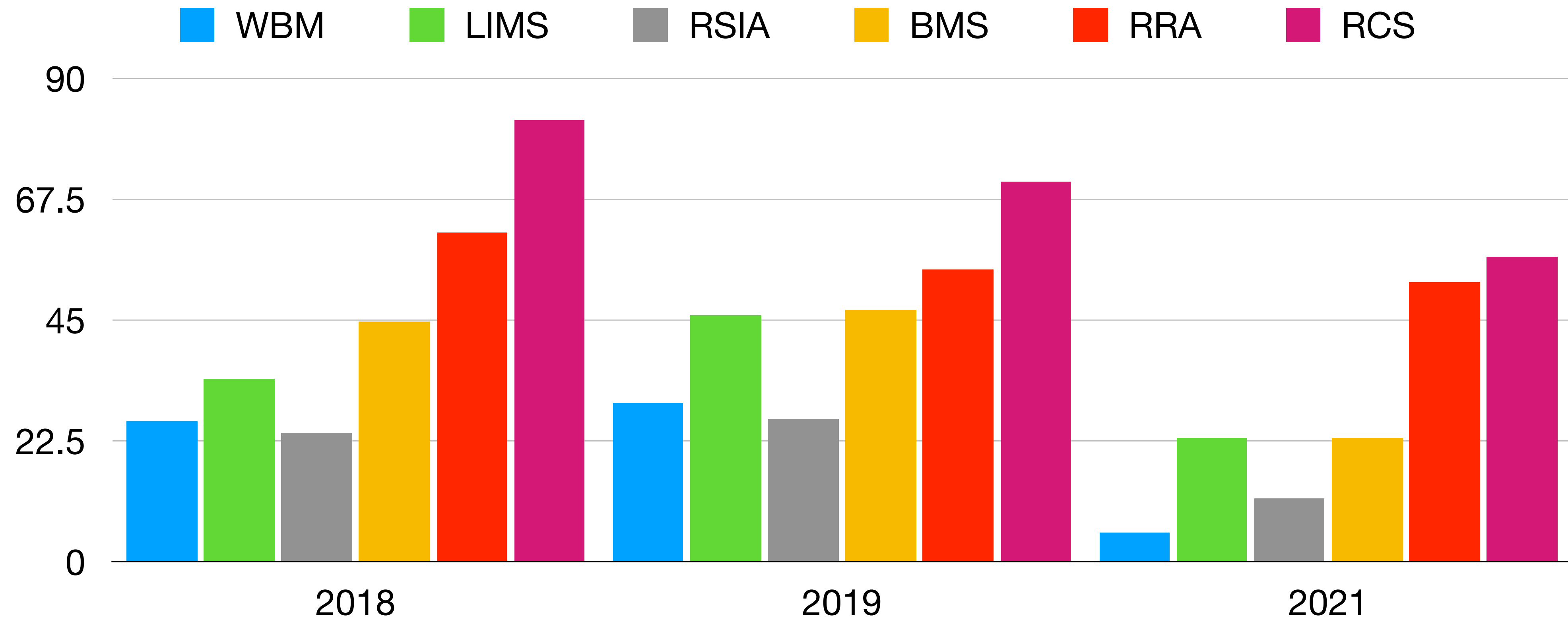
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds Math

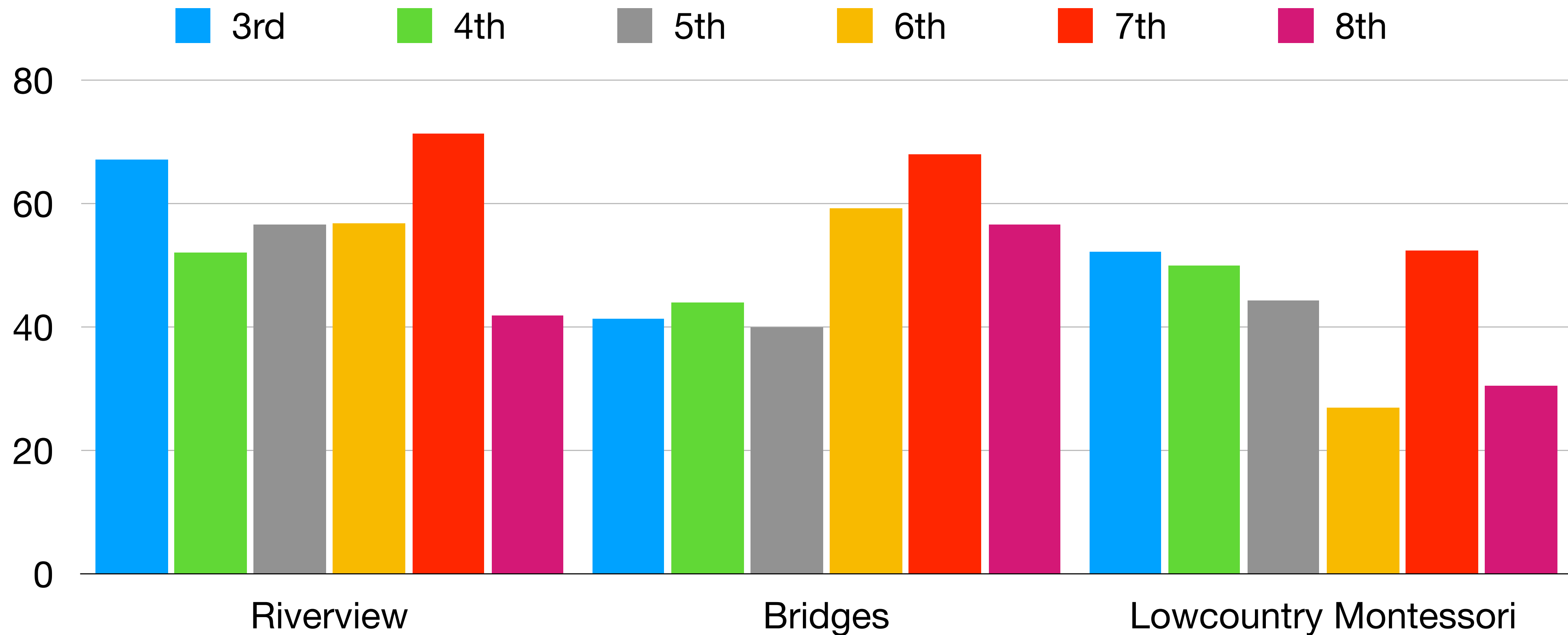

2021 Local Charter School Comparison

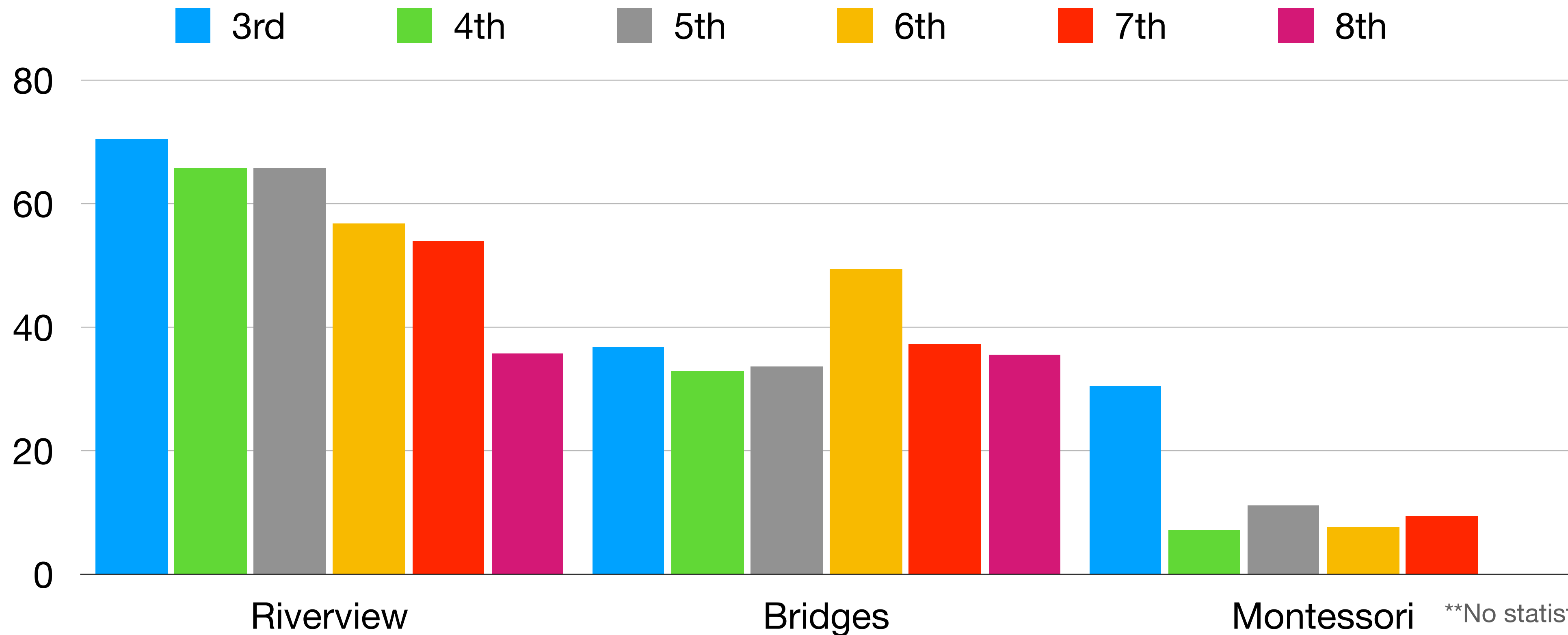
Percent of Students Met or Exceeds ELA

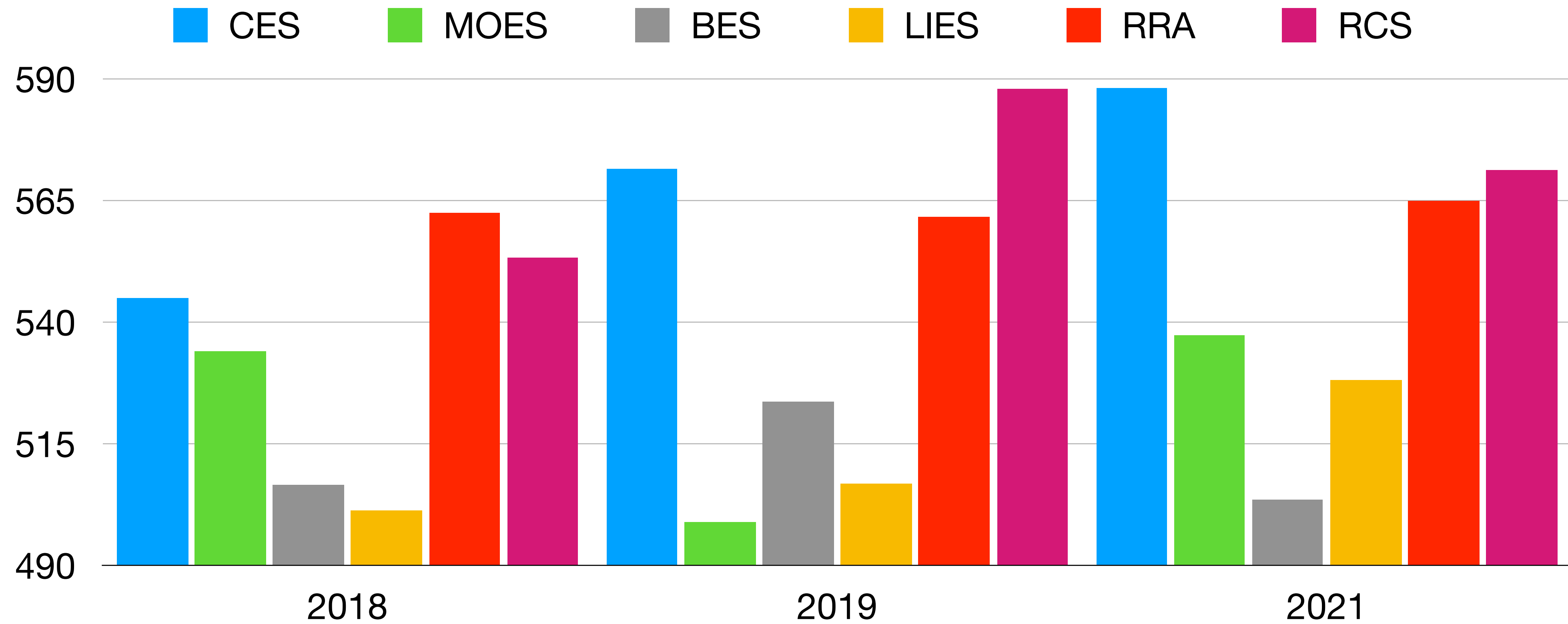

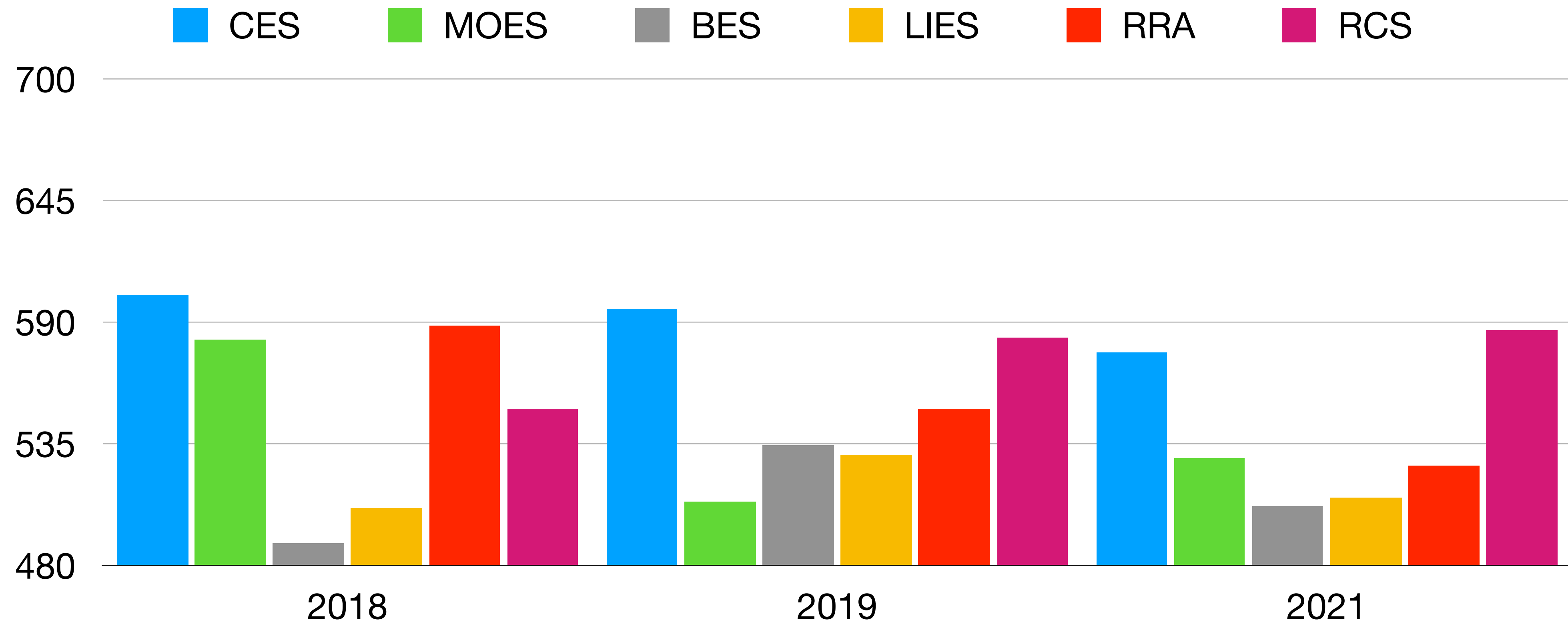
Mean Scores for ELA

Grade 5 Comparison



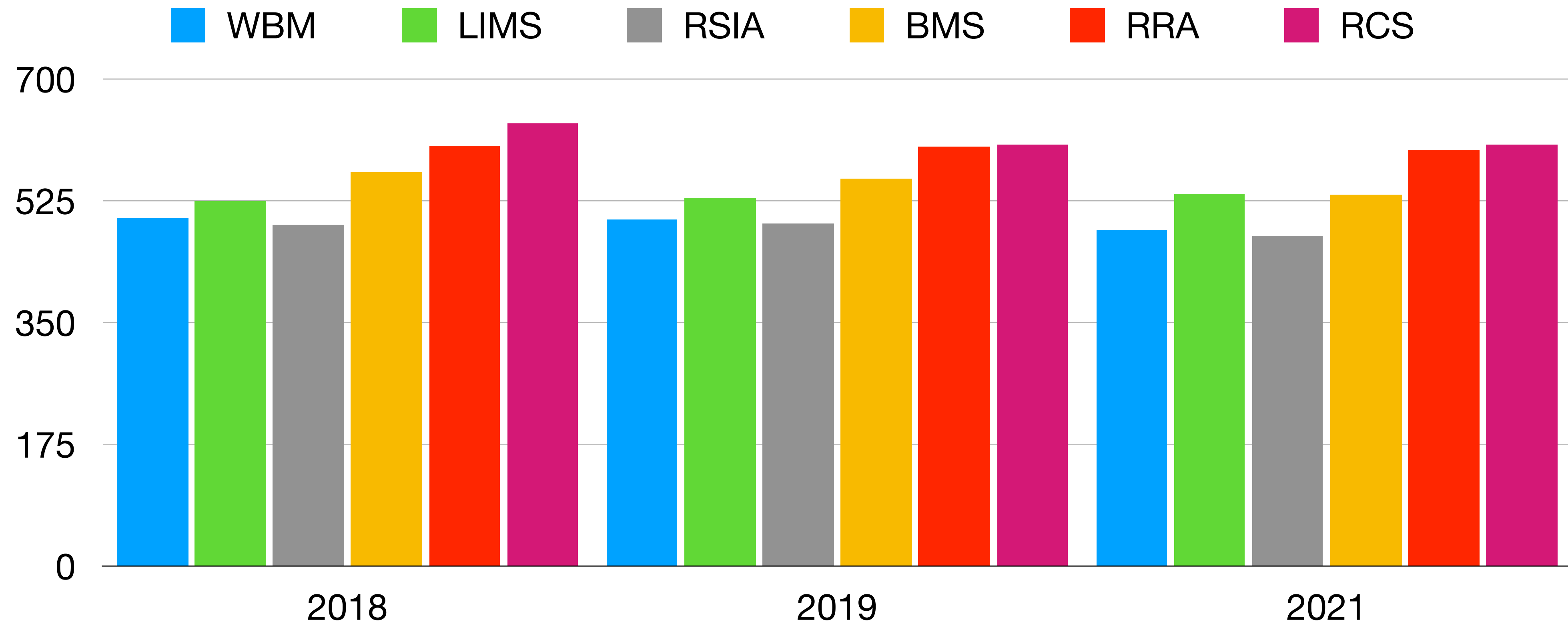
Mean Scores for Math

Grade 5 Comparison



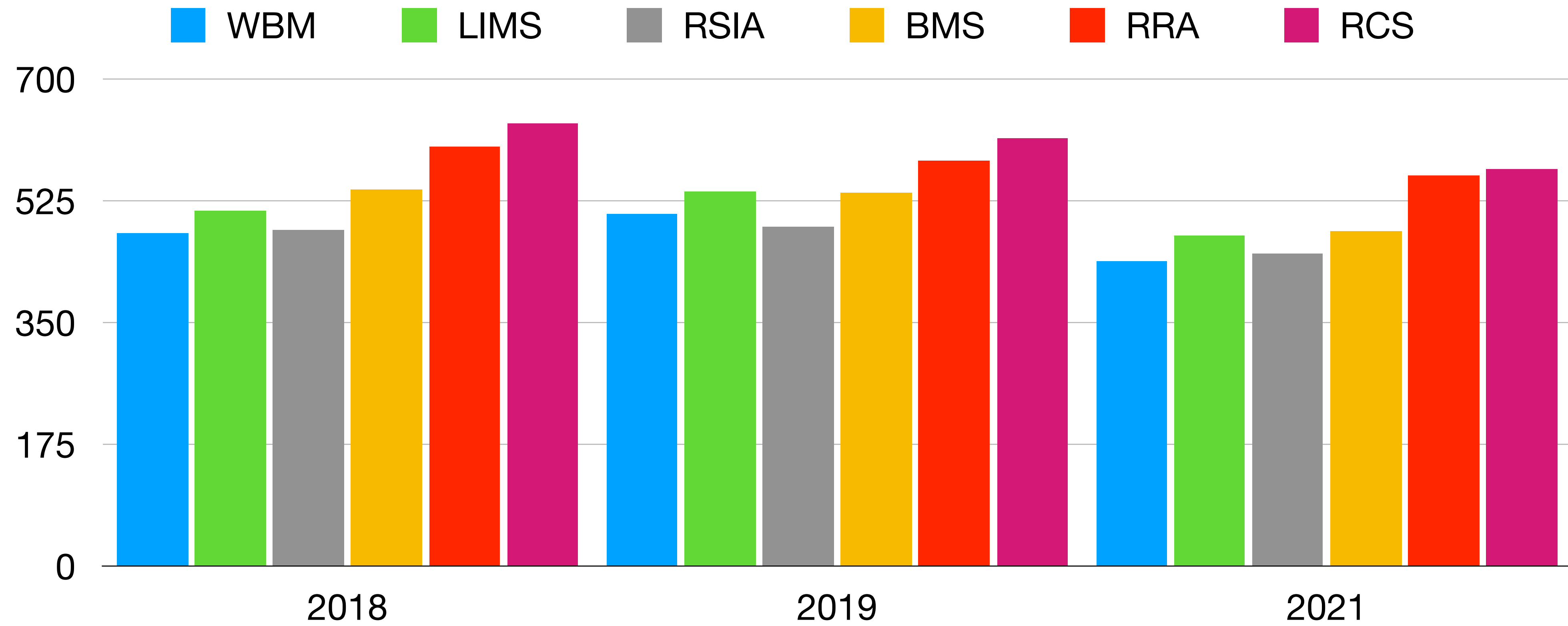
Mean Scores for ELA

Grade 6 Comparison



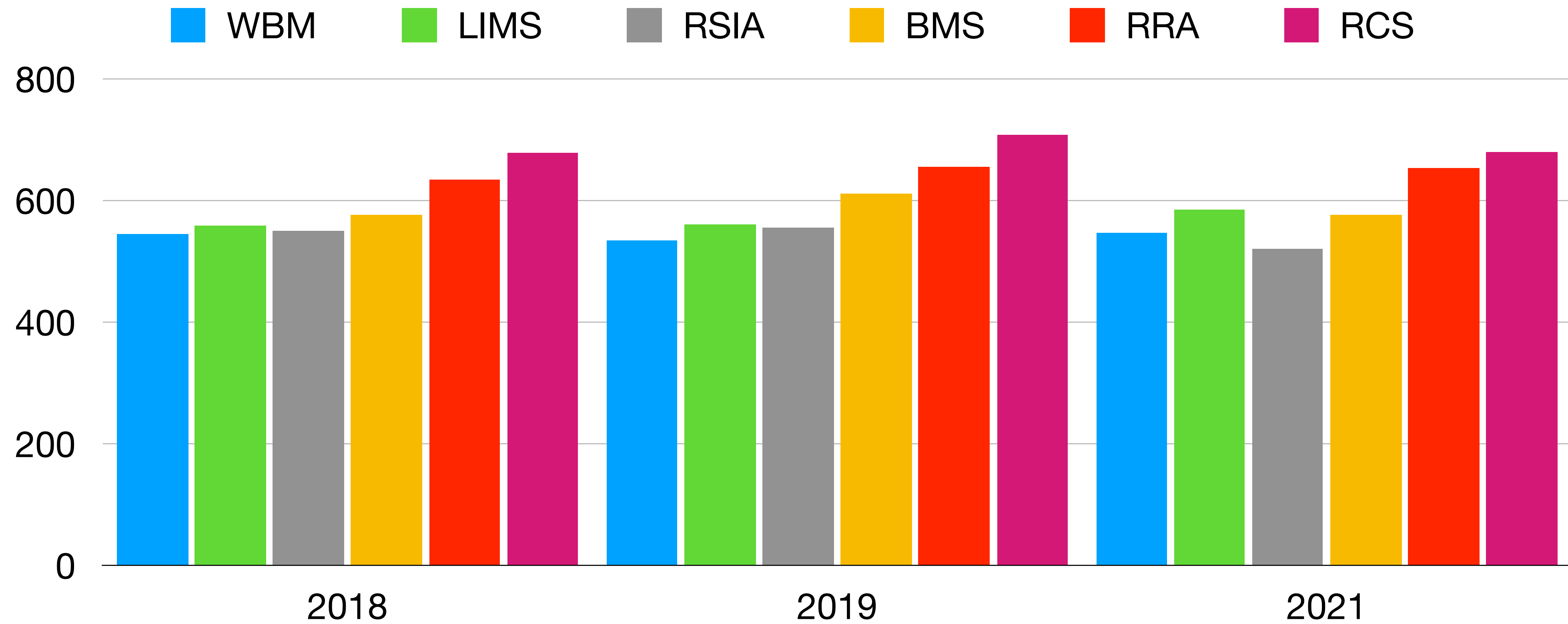
Mean Scores for Math

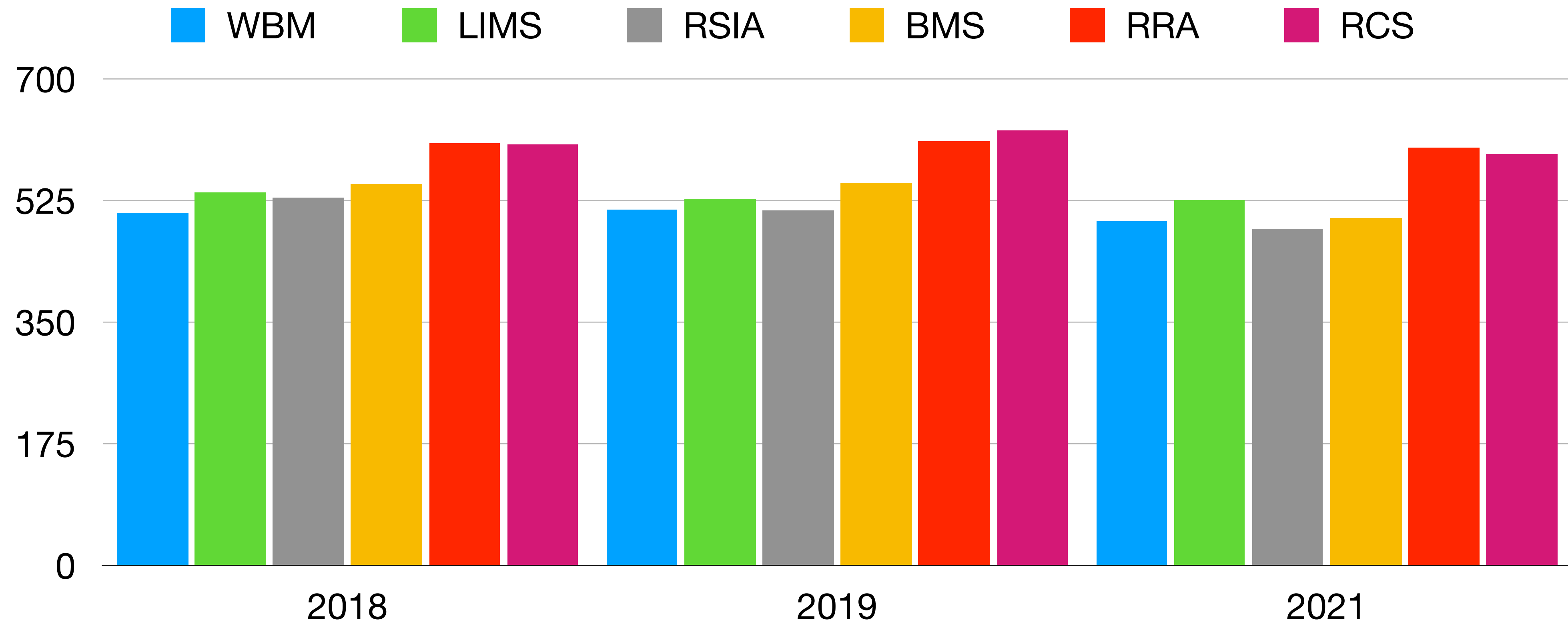

Grade 7 Comparison



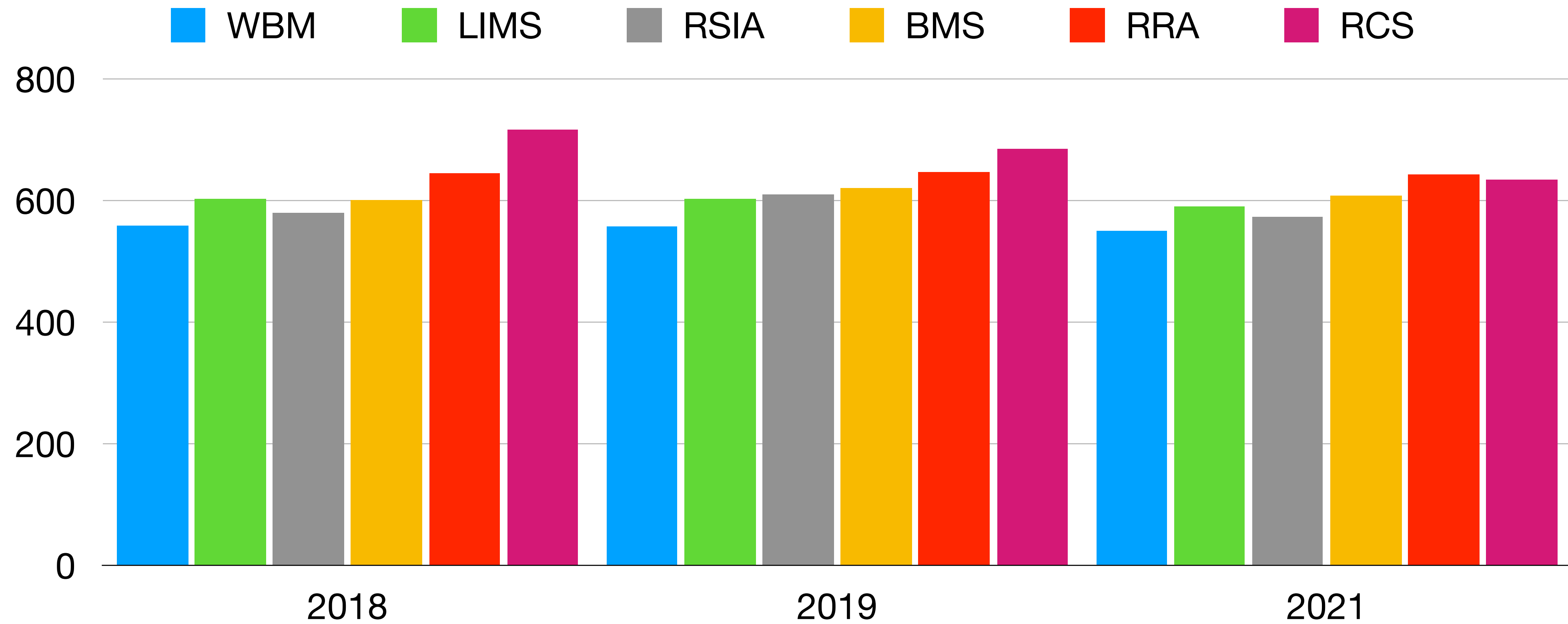
Mean Scores for Math
