# SESSION ONE: AUGUST 16TH-NOVEMBER 16TH

#### **OPTION 1: Full-Time After School Care**

3:00 PM-5:30 PM - \$85.00 per student/week

**REGISTRATION OPEN August 1st!** 

Full-Time After School Care (5 days a week) is until 5:30pm. Should you choose to participate in Enrichment Classes, the cost of those classes is included in your tuition of \$85/week. Priority for the Enrichment Classes is given to Full-Time After School Care participants. **Tuition is billed each Monday following the week of care and is due in full.** Enrollment for Full-Time After School Care is done once a year.

## **OPTION 2: Drop-In Care After School Care**

3:00 PM - 5:30 PM - \$18.00 per student/day

**REGISTRATION OPEN August 1st!** 

This is for those times when occasional care is needed. Please remember to notify the Front Office,
TIDEWATCH Director and your child's homeroom teacher before 1:00 p.m. on the day(s) when your child will
"drop-in" to TIDEWATCH. Drop-in care is totaled each week and your balance is due in full the following
Monday. Enrollment for Drop-In After School Care is done once per school year.

### **Enrichment Classes & Care Before/After**

4:00 PM-5:30 PM - Included in your Full-Time or Drop-In Fees

**REGISTRATION OPEN August 1st!** 

Regardless of attendance, all students enrolled in an Enrichment Class are obligated for the full trimester of fees. Fees are paid weekly each Monday in full. Students will participate in regularly scheduled TIDEWATCH activities before and after their Enrichment Class(es). Space in each Enrichment Class is limited and is offered on a first-come, first-serve basis with priority given to Full- Time After School Care participants. All Enrichment Class fees will be charged based on contracted days including missed days due to illness, parent vacations, etc. No refunds or deductions can be made for days your child is absent. Enrollment for Enrichment Classes is done each Trimester/Session.

#### **MORNING CARE**

7:15 AM-8:10 AM - \$4.00 per student/day

**REGISTRATION OPEN August 1st!** 

Students may participate in quiet games, morning recess, activities, read, and/or complete homework prior to being released for school at 8:10 a.m. Breakfast may be purchased upon arrival. Per Riverview policy, students may not be on or around school grounds unsupervised.

Morning Care is totaled weekly and payment is due in full on the following Monday. Enrollment for Morning Care is done once per school year.



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### **Gymnastics With Mrs. Zapp**

Level 1 & Level 2

#### \*\* Level 2 will now be the earlier class \*\*

The Level 1 class is an introduction to gymnastics and will focus on strength, flexibility, and beginner skill development along with introduction into tumble sills. An evaluation of skills is required to register for the Level 2 class which is designed for the more advanced gymnast. All classes will develop tumbling skills along with an introduction to beam, bar, and vaulting techniques. *Please bring appropriate gym clothes to change into prior to class*.

#### **Cooking with Chef Lisa**

K-2nd & 3rd-8th Grade

Cooking for Kids with 4H Healthy Lifestyle Program. Riverview's own Chef Lisa will educate and excite students to learn cooking basics and healthy lifestyle choices through hands on experiences in the kitchen all while making delicious treats with friends!

### Yoga with Mrs. Prekop

2nd-5th Grade

Students will improve strength, flexibility, gross and fine motor skills while learning yoga poses and sequences in conjunction with the awareness of breath. They will improve concentration and acquire techniques for calming their minds. Games, stories, music and traditional Sanskrit terms will be used. *Please bring appropriate clothes to change into prior to class*.

#### Stitching Stingrays with Mrs. Ieesha

2nd-8th Grade

Learn the art of knitting, hand sewing and crocheting with Mrs. leesha. Students will practice basic skills, create fun projects and earn a lifelong skill all in one class. All supplies will be provided!

#### Soccer with Mr. Woelke

K-3rd & 4th-8th Grade

Students will build basic soccer skills (dribbling, passing, trapping, scoring) to help develop a sense of confidence on the field. Players will also learn sportsmanship and team play. Some small-sided games and drills will be practiced to enhance learning and how to apply those skills in game situations.

## **REGISTRATION & PAYMENTS**

### 1. How do I register?

Online registration is required for ALL TIDEWATCH programs via the Tidewatch Parent Portal. Please visit the RCS website (riverviewcharterschool.org) for Parent Portal log-in instructions and access (available August 1st). A link will be provided for you via email through Constant Contact/ParentSquare.

## 2. How do I select my enrichment classes?

It is helpful to have the TIDEWATCH schedule in front of you when completing your registration. Students will participate in regular TIDEWATCH activities outside of their enrichment class time. When completing your registration, you will be able to select which class you would like your child to participate in. Once your registration is completed and submitted the TIDEWATCH Director will review those requests. Remember, these classes are first come first serve.
